

**Warden Message: Update- H1N1 FLU (INFLUENZA A)
June 17, 2009**

This is an update to the U.S. Embassy's warden message of May 28 regarding the outbreak of H1N1 Influenza.

The World Health Association (WHO) has raised the Pandemic Alert Level to Phase 6. Phase 5 meant that there was "community level transmission" of H1N1 Influenza in one WHO region (the Americas). Phase 6 means there is transmission in another WHO region (Western Pacific). There are now nearly 30,000 confirmed cases spread across 74 countries.
